



CURBSIDE RECYCLING GUIDELINES

PAPER



- » Mail, office, and school papers
- » Newspapers and inserts
- » Magazines and catalogs
- » Paperback books & telephone books
- » Shredded paper – *please place in brown paper bag*
- » Brown paper bags – *can also be used to hold excess recyclables*
- » Fiberboard boxes – *cereal, cracker, storage, and empty pizza boxes*
- » Corrugated cardboard – *flattened and cut in pieces 2' by 3' or smaller, if you have a cart, please place cardboard inside the cart*

PLASTIC



- » Plastic food and beverage containers
- » Plastic bags
- » Styrofoam
- » Detergent bottles
- » Cleaning containers
- » All plastics that are labeled 1-7
- » *Labels do not need to be removed*

CARTONS



- » Food and beverage cartons including:
 - » Milk cartons / creamer
 - » Juice boxes
 - » Soup and broth
 - » Tofu

GLASS



- » Glass bottles and jars: green, brown, and clear
- » *Please place tops/lids in garbage; labels do not need to be removed*

METAL



- » Metal and aluminum cans, empty aerosol cans, aluminum baking tins
- » Steel Food containers
- » *Labels do not need to be removed*

Milk, creamer, juice boxes, soup and broth containers

PLASTICS

Plastics numbered 3-7
